Minnesota State High School League rules apply except as follows:

1. All games played in 12 minute stop time halves. Running time in 2<sup>nd</sup> half if point spread is 15 or more.
2. Two time-outs per half with no carry over. One time-out in overtime. Time-outs are 1 minute in length.
3. Halftime will be 3 minutes long.
4. Overtimes will be 2 minutes stop-time.
5. Only person-to-person defense, no zone defense allowed.
6. Teams may only press the last 2 minutes of each half, unless leading by 15 points or more.
7. All decisions by the officials are final. Technical fouls will be automatic 2 points, plus the ball.
8. The tournament directors have the right to remove spectators demonstrating unsportsmanlike behavior. Please set a positive example for our young athletes.
9. We DO NOT supply warm-up balls, so please bring your own.
10. Certified and/or Experienced Officials will be used.

General information:

- Please be on time for your games. Team rosters need to be supplied to the scorers table prior to each game.
- Individual medals will be awarded in both 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade divisions as follows: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, & 3<sup>rd</sup> in the seven-team divisions; 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, and consolation champions in an eight team division.
- Redwood Valley Public Schools and the Redwood Area Basketball Association are not responsible for accidents or lost items.
- Concessions will be available and we appreciate your support.
- Admission is \$4/adults and \$2/students.
